1 Corinthians 1:10

Salvation is the result of the Holy Spirit's conviction, leading and enlightening, and the cleansing work of the blood of Christ. The declaration of forgiveness by the Father is the result.

In the same way, I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents.

Yet what was I saved from?

Luke 12:5: *But I will show you whom you should fear: Fear him who, after the killing of the body, has power to throw you into hell. Yes, I tell you, fear him.*

Luke 13:5: *I tell you, no! But unless you repent, you too will all perish.*

Revelations 20:10: *And the devil, who deceived them, was thrown into the lake of burning sulfur, where the beast and the false prophet had been thrown. They will be tormented day and night for ever and ever.*

Romans 6:23: *For the wages of sin is death.*

What about the guilt of my past?

Then I acknowledged my sin to you and did not cover up my iniquity. I said, 'I will confess my transgressions to the LORD'-- and you forgave the guilt of my sin.
